Questions for Reflection:

1. Looking back at your notes, what encouraged or challenged you the most?
2. How would you summarize the theme or big idea of the sermon?
3. How have you seen this theme play out in your life, family, or workplace?
4. What did the sermon passage reveal about God and what He wants you to believe, do, or resist?
5. What would the results be in your life if you obeyed or ignored what God wants you to believe, do, or resist?
6. Is there anything you should praise God for or confess to Him as a result of the sermon?
7. 2 Timothy 3:16 says, "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness." With that in mind, what's one personal takeaway you can focus on applying in your life this week?
